# HOW DO I LEAVE A GIFT IN MY WILL?



### It's easy to include a charitable gift in your Will. Creating or updating your Will provides peace of mind, knowing your family will be taken care of and the causes that matter to you will continue to thrive.

To create your Will, simply speak with a lawyer (or a notary in Quebec) or use an online service like Willfora, which helps you create a Will for free.

If you already have a Will, you can add a codicil, a legal clause that can be used to make changes without recreating the entire document. You may also want to consult with a professional advisor to maximize the tax benefits for your estate.
