
A Bequest in Your Will

There are three types of bequests available to you:



3) Contingent Bequest – you make a provision in your Will that your gift only takes effect if your primary intention cannot be met (i.e. if the primary beneficiary and alternate beneficiaries do not live longer than you):

Suggested clause: "If neither (name of primary beneficiary) nor (name of alternate) survives me for 30 days, then I give (description of the amount of cash, percentage of residue, etc.) to Saskatoon City Hospital Foundation, 701 Queen Street, Saskatoon, SK S7K 0M7, to be used for its general charitable purposes."
