Every organization has a unique purpose, a reason for existing. A Mission Statement seeks to articulate that purpose. In developing a mission statement for STMC we reflected on how we are part of the educational ministry of the Catholic Church committed to modelling the life of Jesus, the Divine Teacher. In addition we are inspired by the lived example of our patron, St. Thomas More (1478-1535) a scholar, civic leader and servant of God; and we are guided by the charism of Blessed Edmund Rice (1762-1844) founder of the Christian Brothers. We continue his legacy to make education accessible to the poor and vulnerable. As part of a global network of 280 Edmund Rice Schools in 20 countries, STMC provides a learning environment grounded in the Essential Elements of an Edmund Rice Christian Brothers Education.

While a mission statement captures why we exist a vision statement reflects what we strive to be. A vision is aspirational and future oriented and serves as a catalyst for continued improvement and innovation.

In developing a vision statement for STMC we reflected on the impact we hope to make as a result of our focus on Learning, Leading and Serving. All students, alumni, staff and supporters of STMC are Knights. As a community we support our students and each other to develop to our full capability and then to apply our talents in ways that serve others, especially the vulnerable and marginalized. Our aim is that our individual and collective actions will make our community and our world a better place.

# THE KNIGHTS CROSS



The Knights Cross is an illustration of STMC's holistic approach to faith-based teaching and learning. It is reflective of the Celtic cross - a symbol of Irish Catholic traditions and reminds us of our origins as a Christian Brothers School. The arms of the Cross depict the interaction between faith and the developmental focus on Academics, Arts, Athletics, Advocacy and Action.

**Faith** is at the core of everything we do. STMC's teaching and learning focuses on development of the whole person - mind, spirit and body; and the call to service.

**Academics** focuses on the growth of our mind and includes knowledge related to faith, self, science, technology, arts, and humanities.

Arts promotes creative expression which further enhances our mind and spirit.

**Athletics** adds another dimension of growth and improvement, not just for our mind and spirit, but more specifically for our body.

This holistic approach, within a culture of servant leadership, prepares and compels Knights to respond to the call for service through **Advocacy and Action**.

Finally, these areas of focus are connected by the ring or halo, illustrating the interrelatedness of these areas of focus.
